

Scholastic Scholarship

Criteria

- Have a 3.0 to a 3.49 high school grade point average or an ACT score of 20 to 25
- Enroll full-time in an associate in applied science degree program at Northwestern College
- Must be granted admission to Northwestern College in order for the scholarship to be effective

Award

- \$4,000 total (\$500 each quarter for a maximum of eight quarters)

Requirements

- Submit completed application
- Submit high school transcript
- If scholarship application is based on ACT score, submit ACT results to Northwestern College
- Meet all admission requirements and be granted admission to Northwestern College
- Maintain continuous full-time status in declared major each quarter
- Maintain a 3.0 or higher grade point average
- Have no outstanding debt to the College

Conditions

- Northwestern College scholarships are not redeemable for cash, are nontransferable, and can only be applied to tuition.

Deadline: Two weeks prior to the start of the quarter.

Scholastic Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students demonstrating scholastic merit by earning a high school grade point average of 3.0 to 3.49 on a 4-point scale or a score of 20 to 25 on the ACT. The College will offer a maximum of 15 Scholastic Scholarships annually to students who enroll full-time in an associate in applied science degree program at Northwestern College.

Applicants are required to submit this application form with copies of their high school transcript and/or copies of their ACT scores. All entries remain the property of Northwestern College and will not be returned. Recipients are selected by the Scholarship Committee. Each winner receives a \$4,000 scholarship that will be applied to tuition at the rate of \$500 per quarter.

All scholarships are nontransferable and must be used in conjunction with an associate in applied science degree program. Quarterly application to tuition is automatic as long as a 3.0 cumulative grade point average, continuous enrollment, and full-time status in the declared major are maintained, and there is no outstanding debt to the College.

The Scholastic Scholarship may not be combined with any other Northwestern College scholarship. This scholarship may not be combined with Northwestern College employee benefits.

Deadline: Two weeks prior to the start of the quarter.
