Boolean Searching


Boolean, Keyword & Advanced Searches

Boolean is a system for logical operations. Boolean operators are:

*And, Or, Not

And is used to narrow a search.

Example: Raise your hand if you are a student <u>and</u> you are wearing blue jeans.



Boolean cont'd.

Or is used to broaden a search.

Example: Raise your hand if you are a business major <u>or</u> a health information technology major.



Boolean cont'd.

Not is used to exclude a search concept.

Example: Raise your hand if you are a student but

<u>not</u> a legal studies major.
