Excerpted from the *Northwestern College Electric Media and Computer Use Policy*

- **Altering or Tampering with College Software and/or Equipment.** Installing or removing hardware, software, and/or application patches (e.g. screensavers, drivers, service packs, updated versions) is strictly prohibited.
- **Unacceptable Uses.** Electronic media may not be used for knowingly transmitting, retrieving or storing of any communications of a discriminatory or harassing nature, or which are derogatory to any individual or group, or which are obscene or "X-rated" communications, or are of a defamatory or threatening nature, or for "chain letters," or for any other purpose which is illegal or against College policy or contrary to the College's interest. *The viewing of sexually explicit or "X-rated" Web sites is strictly prohibited.*
- **Acceptable Uses.** Acceptable uses of electronic media by students include class assignments or in support of the same; for educational research purposes; and to facilitate communication between students and college employees. Occasional Internet surfing is acceptable.
