Excerpted from the Northwestern College Electric Media and Computer Use Policy

- Altering or Tampering with College Software and/or Equipment.
 Installing or removing hardware, software, and/or application patches (e.g. screensavers, drivers, service packs, updated versions) is strictly prohibited.
- Unacceptable Uses. Electronic media may not be used for knowingly transmitting, retrieving or storing of any communications of a discriminatory or harassing nature, or which are derogatory to any individual or group, or which are obscene or "X-rated" communications, or are of a defamatory or threatening nature, or for "chain letters," or for any other purpose which is illegal or against College policy or contrary to the College's interest. The viewing of sexually explicit or "X-rated" Web sites is strictly prohibited.
- Acceptable Uses. Acceptable uses of electronic media by students include class assignments or in support of the same; for educational research purposes; and to facilitate communication between students and college employees. Occasional Internet surfing is acceptable.
