

Early Acceptance Award

Criteria

- Be a graduating 2020 high school senior
- Apply for and start classes in either the Summer or Fall 2020 quarter
- Enroll as a full-time freshman at Northwestern College or take the maximum credits allowed according to the admission requirements
- Take and pass the Wonderlic entrance exam or have either a composite score of 15 on the ACT or 810 on the SAT

Award amount varies by deadline dates

Degree

- **Level 1:** Before **January 31, 2020** - **up to \$6,000** (up to \$750 each quarter for a maximum of eight quarters)
- **Level 2:** February 1 to **June 30, 2020** - **up to \$4,000** (up to \$500 each quarter for a maximum of eight quarters)
- **Level 3:** July 1 to **September 30, 2020** - **up to \$2,000** (up to \$250 each quarter for a maximum of eight quarters)

Certificate

- **Level 1:** Before **January 31, 2020** - **up to \$3,000** (up to \$750 each quarter for a maximum of four quarters)
- **Level 2:** February 1 to **June 30, 2020** - **up to \$2,000** (up to \$500 each quarter for a maximum of four quarters)
- **Level 3:** July 1 to **September 30, 2020** - **up to \$1,000** (up to \$250 each quarter for a maximum of four quarters)

Requirements

- Submit completed application
- Submit copies of both your high school transcript and ACT or SAT
- Meet all admission requirements and be granted admission to Northwestern College
- Maintain continuous full-time enrollment status in declared major each quarter
- Maintain a 3.0 or higher cumulative grade point average
- Student financial account must remain in good standing at all times

Conditions

- Northwestern College scholarships are not redeemable for cash, are nontransferable, and can only be applied to tuition.

Early Acceptance Award

This award is available in the **Summer or Fall 2020** quarter to high school graduates who are admitted to Northwestern College as entering freshmen and take the maximum credits allowed according to the admission requirements.

Applicants are required to submit this application form, a copy of their high school transcript, and a copy of either an ACT/SAT or students must take and pass the Wonderlic Entrance Exam, and be granted admission to Northwestern College in order for the award to be effective. All entries remain the property of Northwestern College and will not be returned.

Early Acceptance recipients will be awarded the dollar amounts that correspond to the dates when the admissions application and all supporting documents were submitted:

Degree

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All scholarships are not redeemable for cash, are nontransferable and must be used in conjunction with a program. Quarterly application to tuition is automatic as long as a 3.0 cumulative grade point average, continuous enrollment, and full-time status in the declared major are maintained, and there is no outstanding debt to the College. This award may be used in conjunction with another Northwestern College scholarship for high school seniors. This award may not be combined with Northwestern College employee benefits.
