Library Databases

Accessible inside and outside the library:

EBSCOhost https://search.ebscohost.com. Full-text articles from scholarly journals, newspapers, and e-books in wide-ranging subjects. Includes the CINAHL database for Nursing. EBSCO is also providing a complimentary Coronavirus research database at https://covid19.ebscomedical.com/

<u>FirstSearch</u> <u>https://newfirstsearch.oclc.org.</u> Search materials available in the Schumacher library and other libraries around the world. If you find books you need that are available in or out of state, we can borrow them through Interlibrary Loan (ILL) for you.

<u>Hein Online</u> https://heinonline.org/HOL/Welcome Database with information on Civil Rights and Social Justice, Gun Regulation, and Slavery in America and the world.

<u>Issues and Controversies</u> <u>https://online.infobaselearning.com.</u> Provides in-depth investigations of today's top issues, including politics, business, government and society, family and community, education, and popular culture. It includes a wire-service newsfeed that provides the latest headline stories, a video overview, and polling on a question related to the topic.

<u>Overdrive</u> <u>https://nilrc.overdrive.com</u> Provides access to over 7000 eBooks and audiobooks that can be checked out either on the website or by downloading the Libby app on a smartphone. Login using 7 digit student ID number.

ProQuest https://search.proquest.com. Access to periodical databases and scholarly collections in multiple fields. Subjects range from arts, literature, and social science to general reference, business, science, technology, and more. Also has a Coronavirus Research database and a database of Publicly Available Content. ProQuest has also put together a 5 part video series on the Coronavirus available for free through YouTube.

<u>Salem Health</u> https://online.salempress.com. Up-to-date medical information useful for research. Full-text articles may be accessed by typing a term into the search box. Three reference sets are available (Complementary and Alternative Medicine, Magill's Medical Guide, and Psychology and Behavioral Health) which offer alphabetized lists of subject headings. Also provides complimentary access to content on Pandemics, Civil Disobedience, Treaties in the News, and Ukraine and Russia.
